I am pleased to inform that CT Group Institute invite students of MBA to participate in TCS MBA Hiring 2026 as per the below mentioned details:-

Last date of registration	: 11-Feb-26 (Wednesday)
Courses Eligible	: MBA
Eligible Streams	: Marketing/Finance/ Operations/ Supply Chain Management/ Technology/ General Management/ Business Analytics/ Project Management.
Batch Eligible	: 2026 passing out

TCS Eligibility Criteria:

- **Academic Percentage:** Candidates should have a minimum aggregate (All subjects in all semesters) of 60% or equivalent CGPA in class 10th, 12th, Diploma (if applicable), Graduation and Post-Graduation examination.
- **Highest Qualification:** Candidates pursuing 2 years full-time Management Post Graduate courses (MBA/MMS/PGDBA/PGDM) offered by a recognized university with specializations in Marketing/ Finance/Operations/Supply Chain Management/Information Technology/General Management/ Business Analytics/Project Management/or related disciplines offered by recognized university/college from the batch of 2026 will be considered.
- **Backlogs/Arrears/ATKT:** Candidate having up to one backlog may appear for the selection process. However, it is mandatory that the course is completed within the stipulated time duration without any backlogs at the time of joining TCS, if selected.
- **Extended Education:** No extended education would be allowed. Candidates should have completed the course in the stipulated course duration.
- **Gap/Break in Education:** It is mandatory to declare gaps in education, if any. Overall academic gap should not exceed 24 months until the highest qualification. Relevant documentation, as applicable, will be checked for gaps in education.
- **Course Types:** Only full-time courses will be considered (part-time/correspondence courses will not be considered).
- **Open Schooling:** Candidates who have completed their Secondary and/or Senior Secondary courses from NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling) are also eligible to apply if the Graduation and Post-graduation (if applicable) courses are done full-time.

- **Work Experience:** Candidates with prior work experience of 0-2 years are eligible for TCS MBA Hiring 2026. Any experience (part-time/ full-time) is required to be mandatory declared in the TCS Application Form. Candidates would be required to submit the necessary documents supporting their work experience at the time of TCS selection process and/or post joining TCS, as per requirements.
- **Age:** Minimum age - 18 years and maximum age - 28 years.

Students must register and fill up the application form on the TCS NextStep portal (if not done already). The status of the student should be **"Applied for Drive"**. This is important to be included in the test process.

Steps to complete the Application Process:-

Step 1. Login to the TCS Next Step Portal

Step 2. Register and apply for the drive.

- **Scenario A.** If you are already a registered user in the TCS Next Step Portal, 'IT' category, kindly login with your TCS Reference ID (CT/DT reference number) and proceed to complete the application form. Upon submission, kindly click on 'Apply for Drive'.
- **Scenario B.** If candidate is a new user, s/he can click on Register Now, choose category as 'IT' and proceed to fill the details. The candidate can then submit his/her application form and click on 'Apply For Drive'.

Step 3. Select your mode of test (In-Centre) and choose your preferred test centre & then click on Apply.

Step 4. To confirm your status, check "Track your application". The status should be reflected as "Applied for Drive".

TCS have a stringent eligibility criterion and a robust selection process. Eligibility as per the defined criteria will be checked at various stages of the selection process. At any point of time if students are found ineligible, or data shared by you is found discrepant, student candidature will be disqualified.

Important Points:

This will be In-center test and center allotment would be on a **first-come-first-serve basis**.
